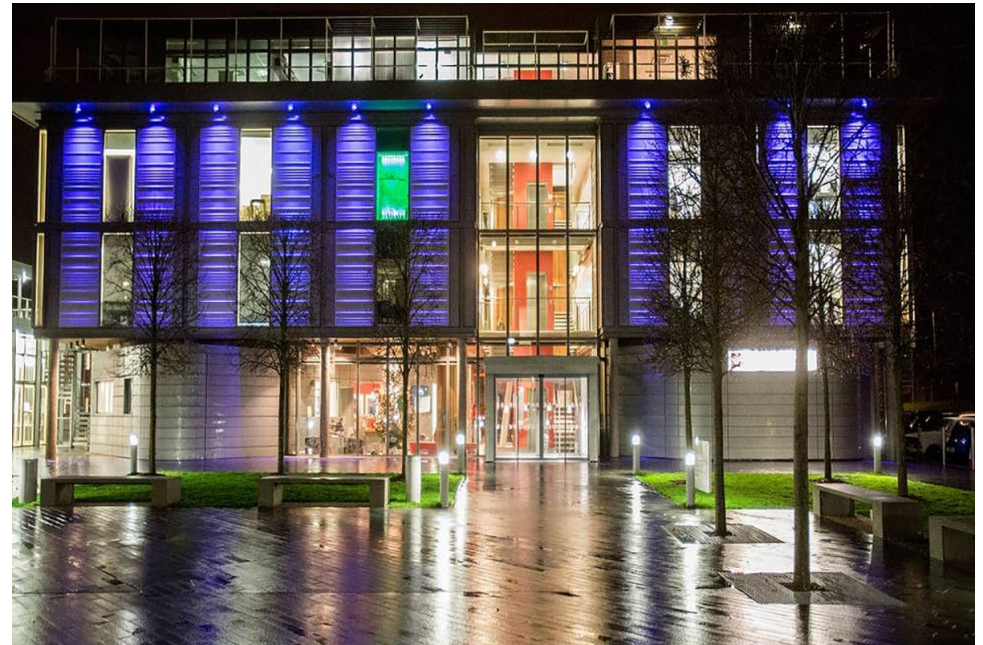

- Apply via UCAS for entry to year 1, 2 and 3

Portfolio Guideline

- Course-specific guidelines on AUB website
- www.aub.ac.uk/portfolios
- around 20 pieces; variety of work & media
- demonstration of skills - *ability to draw*
- sketchbooks, journals and experimentation
- polished, finished pieces & work in progress
- link to a digital portfolio on web platform



Auditions

- Performance-based
- Detailed information in audition guidelines
- Information via MyApplication & email
- *You will not see this information on UCAS Track*
- *Submit digital audition as per guidelines*



What happens next?

- Please submit portfolio within 30 days of request
- Email admissions if delay in submitting
- Portfolio/ audition assessed by course teams
- Decisions to admissions team
- Who process and send to UCAS and update MyApplication
- Offer letter



Courses that do not require a portfolio

- If you have standard qualifications in relevant subject
- we can make an offer based on application
- *This will be most applicants*
- ‘Non-standard’ qualifications?

- Admissions may request a portfolio or more information may be needed
- For example Creative Writing may need sample of your writing



Entry Requirements

Offers made at around 112- 120 UCAS Tariff points:

- **Pass on the Foundation Diploma meets entry requirement**
- BBB/BBC at A Level (AB for Architecture)
- DDM/DMM at BTEC Extended Diploma
- M at UAL Extended Diploma
- IB Diploma/ Certificates
- Other equivalent Level 3 qualifications, or a combination of qualifications

English Language Requirements

We accept a wide range including (but not limited to):

EU/EEA applicants

GCSE/IGCSE English Language or Literature at grade 4

Level 2 Functional Skills English

EU/EEA and Overseas applicants

IELTS 6.0 overall with minimum 5.5 on each band

IB English Language B or English Language and Literature A at HL with a grade of 4 or SL with a grade of 5

Your offer

- View our decision on UCAS Track and also on MyApplication
 - **Conditional Offer**
 - Unconditional Offer
- No offer ?
- Foundation Diploma may be recommended



Confirmation

- Most results sent to us via UCAS
- If you meet the conditions of offer it is unconditional
- UCAS Track & MyApplication updated
- A Level & BTEC results day

Other qualifications?

- Decisions confirmed as results receive
- If you have not heard or your offer is still conditional then contact admissions



What happens if I don't meet my offer?

- AUB looking for qualities that will make a successful student
- “Near miss” - If you narrowly miss meeting your offer, you will still be considered
- Final decision made taking into account whole application

Extenuating circumstances?

then your school/college should contact admissions in writing before results released

- Don't rule yourself out- make an application

Foundation Diploma in Art & Design / Media

- Opportunity to explore a broad range of disciplines
- Two pathways available:
 - Art and Design
 - Media

Who should consider this route?

- Not sure which degree course is best for you?
- Need to refine and develop skills or portfolio?
- Provides excellent transition to more specialised degree courses

After Foundation

- Successful completion of the Foundation Diploma at AUB guarantees a place on a degree course
- Apply directly to AUB by end of March - online application
- Do not apply via UCAS
- Entry requirements:
 - 5 GCSEs grade of 4 or above, must include **Maths and English**
 - CC at A Level or equivalent Level 3 qualification in relevant creative subject
- ***No tuition fees*** for UK students aged under 19 on 31st August
- Students 19+ can apply for Advanced Learner Loan to cover tuition fees (GOV.UK for info)- ***no maintenance loan***
